Sayyid Hassan Nasrallah (1960-2024)

Hezbollah was established by Lebanese Shia leaders to fight the 1982 Israeli invasion of Lebanon. The organization was created wit support of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC)of Iran that trained and mentored the group.

He became secretary general in 1992.

Nasrallah was murdered on September 27, 2024 by Zionist airstrikes.

The previous secretary-general of Hezbollah, Abbas al-Musawi (1952–1992), was assassination by Israel in 1992.

The historical significance of Nasrallah

- Building a formidable political and military organization
- Establishing the authority of Hezbollah as a central part of the axis of resistance
- Leading Hezbollah in defeating Israel in 2006 war
- Leading the response to the ongoing Gaza genocide

The significance of his martyrdom


- The leader is not the organization: killing a leader is not killing the organization
- The martyrdom is not regarded as a defeat, but as a victory for the martyr: compare the role of Che Guevara or general Suleimani in the anti-imperialist movement

The course of the liberation struggle
